
'Eternal Gandhi', a new media art and technology exhibition on the life and principals of Mahatma Gandhi has begun today at the Gujarat Science City.

The exhibition is unique for the way multimedia has been used to enliven the historical events associated with Gandhiji. The exhibition uses classical symbols like spinning wheels, prayer wheels, tactile mode of expression to drive home Gandhi's views on non-violence, non-possession, fearlessness and commitments to truth.

"The idea behind the exhibition is to propagate Gandhian ideas and philosophy with the use of developed technology that transports Gandhian ideal into the newer world of information technology and product design. Modern design is interpreted through the Gandhian commitment to modern hand-made production and its symbolic relationship to nature," said Bharat Parekh, General Manager, Aditya Birla Group that is organising the exhibition for the first time in the State.

The exhibition was earlier showcased in Mumbai, Delhi and Pune. From Ahmedabad, the exhibition will also travel to cities like Chennai, Bangalore, Hyderabad and Kolkata.

"We are also talking with the Ministry of Railways for starting Ahimsa Express, a train that will carry the exhibition to places associated with Gandhi," said Rajshree Birla, Chairperson of the Aditya Birla Group.
